From the Pastor's Desk

Thanksgiving!

God is certainly worthy of praise and thanksgiving, and in Psalm 100 the writer gives us a wonderful glimpse into the world of a thankful spirit. It is an invitation to enter joyfully into God's presence. Verse one tells us to "*make a joyful noise unto the Lord, all ye lands*". Joyful noise is not unnecessary shouting but an excited and happy sound. Sometimes we are too quiet, to anemic in the service.

Verse two says "serve the Lord with gladness: come before His presence with singing". If our attitudes and motives are right about serving God, then we will find joy in serving Him. You may not be able to carry a tune, but you can lift up your voice with some kind of praise. Everyone should have a song in their heart!

Verse three says "know ye that the Lord he is God: and it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves: we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture". The Psalmist tells us to acknowledge that the Lord is God! We appreciate his status as our Creator, accept his authority in every detail of our lives. We are His people---chosen, forgiven and justified. We are His sheep---less than the shepherd, needing His guidance and feeding in His pasture.

Verse four tells us how to enter into the service to feel the presence of God, it says "enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him and bless his name". God gives us an invitation into His presence. Do you willfully and joyfully come into God's presence, or are you just going through the motions, reluctantly going to church? Have you drawn closer to Him or do you find yourself fleeing from His presence? God alone is worthy of being worshipped!

Verse five tells us why He is worthy to be praised. The Psalmist writes "for the Lord is good: his mercy is everlasting: and his truth endures to all generations". He is good because that is His nature (kindness, generous, patient, loving). He is good because He saves. He is good because He keeps His mercy. His mercy, which is Him withholding from us what we deserve, extends to humanity, is evidenced in salvation and seen in our daily lives. Truth is an indispensable attribute of God. His Word is truth (unchanging fact), and it never ends and can always be counted on.

In a few days we will sit around a table full of good food and spend time with family. We will stuff ourselves silly and watch a football game or just talk and have a good time. What about sharing with someone this Thanksgiving about God and His goodness, mercy and truth.
