

From the Pastor's Desk

THE WORD WAS MADE FLESH!

John 1:1-5 lets us know that "in the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God, the same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by him; and without him was not any thing made that was made. In him was life; and the life was the light of men, and the light shineth in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not".

Perhaps about A.D. 90 God led the elderly disciple John to give the churches near Ephesus he had so faithfully served information in writing that would lead people to believe that Jesus Christ is God's Son and so have life. He wrote his gospel to help the churches understand the way to be faithful in a world of persecution, ridicule, and religious competition.

Jesus Christ came into this world to reveal His Father's mind to us concerning the great matters of our salvation. Were it not for Christ's manhood, the sight of the Godhead would be formidable to us; but through Christ's flesh we may look upon God without fear. Christ's person in two natures being the God-Man looks upon his human nature as incarnate while retaining His divine nature.

Christ took our flesh so that He might know what it is to be faint, sorrowful, tempted. Isaiah 7:14 says "therefore, the Lord himself shall give you a sign; behold a virgin shall conceive, and bear as son and shall call his name Immanuel". The wisdom of God has astonished men and angels. If God had put us to find out a way of salvation when we were lost, we could neither have had a head to devise, nor a heart to desire.

But here was the masterpiece of divine wisdom, to contrive a way to happiness between the sin of man and the justice of God. Jesus Christ would become our mediator, our redeemer to reconcile us back to God.

"...Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace."

Isaiah 9:6 says "for unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given; and the government shall be upon his shoulder; and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counselor, the Mighty God, the Everlasting Father, the Prince of Peace".

Thank God for Jesus who in Him dwells the fulness of the Godhead (Colossians 2:9). He is of the same nature and essence with the Father. John 14:1 Jesus said 'ye believe in God, believe also in me". You see in the fullness of time God sent forth his Son, made of a woman (Gal 4:4).

Christ incarnate is nothing but love covered with flesh. As Christ's assuming our human nature was a master-piece of wisdom, so it was a monument of free grace. The Word became flesh and love was the intrinsic motive.
