

It's Time to Believe!



Two thousand years ago, while human beings were at their lowest point, God put into motion his plan to save us. Jesus, seated at the right hand of God, gave up all his power in heaven and exploded into human history. "he himself bore our sins in his body on the tree, that we might die to sin and live to righteousness. By his wounds you have been saved" (1Peter 2:24, ESV.


