From the Pastors Desk

A Community of Believers!

The most common term used today to describe followers of Jesus is "Christian." But did you know that Jesus never used that word? In fact, it's only used three times in the New Testament (Acts 26:28, 1Peter 4:16 and Acts 11:26). The primary term used in the Bible for believers in Christ is disciples. This word describes not only who the church is but what it is to do. We are disciples of Christ who are called to make disciples and teach them to live as He desires (Matthew 28:19-20).

You are a disciple of Christ if at some point in your life you realized you were a sinner, believed that Jesus died on the cross for you, and surrendered your life to Him as your Savior and Lord. At that moment, you became a part of the body of Christ. Although you become a believer individually, you are not meant to live the Christian life alone. Every Christian should be a part of a local body of believers for the purpose of fellowship, encouragement, and spiritual growth.

Relationships were essential in the early church, but our culture has redefined them. Verbal face-to-face conversations have been replaced by tweeting, texting, and posting. Instead of being knit to-gether in a loving community, many Christians have opted for becoming spectators in a church worship service for one hour a week. However, being a Lone Ranger Christian is not what is modeled in the New Testament.

The early church became a loving community with intimate relationships with one another. How could they do this? The answer is simple "Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts" (Acts 2:46).

They didn't have church buildings like we have today, the custom was to meet in homes. Today we would equate this with small groups. Whether you gather in Bible studies, Sunday school classes, informal gatherings, or organized small groups, the goal is to build close relationships with one another.

These early believers were committed to Jesus through the study of His Word, prayer, and the Lord's supper, but they were also committed to each other. They fellowshipped with each other by eating together, praying, sharing their struggles, encouraging one another, and growing together in their faith.

Can you imagine what could happen in a church and to a community if we would link arms with our spiritual brothers and sisters in a local church and walk together through life with our Savior!! It saddens my spirit to see believers not taking advantage of this great community that Jesus left heaven and came to earth to die on a cross to make us a part of His family and walk with us each day.

The devotion centered on the beauty of flowers. This is one of the poems included:


In the tiny petals of a tiny flower


Ambassadors Soccer Camp
