### From the Pastor's Desk

#### The Bible is Powerful



The Word of God can transform any situation or person, because built into it is the ability to pull off whatever God desires it to accomplish. Power is the ability to affect change or produce the desired effect. This is a good working definition of what I mean by the power of God's word.

A key Scripture passage that teaches this truth is found in that great section of Isaiah 55 where we are told in verse 11 "so will My word be which goes forth from My mouth; it will not return to Me empty, without accomplishing what I desire, and without succeeding in the matter for which I sent it".

The unstoppable power of God's word is another attribute that sets it apart from anyone else's word. We humans spew out a lot of words, and people make all manner of boasts, promises, and threats. But a lot of what we say never comes to pass, for which we can be thankful. Our plans are frustrated all the time because we are not all-powerful.

God's word has no shortcomings. It cannot be frustrated or stopped. His Word is always purposeful when it goes out from His mouth, and that purpose is always achieved. He always has a plan that He intends to fulfill.

When the writers of Scripture wanted to illustrate the awesome power of God, they often pointed to His creation of the world

The psalmist declared, "by the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and by the breath of His mouth all their host" (Psalm 33:6). Then he added in verse 9, "For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast," referring to the earth and all of its mighty oceans.

To simply speak a world into existence is power beyond anything we can imagine. In chapter one of the book of Genesis it is recorded again and again that "<u>God said...and it was so</u>". In other words, God did not need any raw materials to work with when He created the world. He created the raw materials and everything else with His word. This is creation, making not just something out of nothing, but *everything* out of nothing.

The Apostle Paul puts it like this in Romans 4:17. He said that God "calls into being that which does not exist". Now the fact that God can speak and make it so ought to be good news when you look at your circumstances and don't see any way that anything can happen. Remember that God doesn't need anything to do His work, because His word is powerful and all of God's authority stands behind the Bible.
