God promised that "every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low; the crooked places shall be made straight, and the rough places smooth; the glory of the Lord shall be revealed, and all flesh shall see it together; for the mouth of the Lord has spoken". God promised to give power to the weak and to increase the strength of those who have no might. He is saying I know you are growing weary with the conditions of your world, and I know many are wondering when a change for the good will come. But He encourages us in verse 31 of chapter 40 when He says" but those who wait on the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint".
